Writing	Join a forum and post messages in English to other users. Try: http://messages.yahoo.com/index.html
Reading	Read a web-page with software such as the <i>Oxford Genie</i> (OUP) or the 'QuickSearch' facility on the <i>Macmillan English Dictionary</i> . Search for a text in your field using a search engine such as <i>Google</i> http://www.google.com
Phonology	Listen to the phonemic symbols in English http://www2.arts.gla.ac.uk/IPA/ipa.html
